

1. Why Subjective Assessment?

Want to assess or evaluate...

- 1. Cognition: High order thinking skill
 - Complex or abstract concepts
 - Detailed and specific feedback
- 2. Psychomotor cognitive part
- 3. Attitude & Value cognitive part



1. Why Subjective Assessment? (2)


Want to assess or evaluate...

- 4. Personalized need & learning styles
- 5. Enhance communication skill Writing skill / Oral Q&A or Interview
- 6. Group work



Cognitive Domain

Bloom's Taxonomy





2. What/How to ask for Cognitive Domain?

- 1. Remember (Fill in the blank, short answers)
 - → Recall essential minimal knowledge
- 2. Understand (Short essays)
 - → Explain with understanding
 - → Describe standard process (include cognitive part of psychomotor)
 - → Explain different points of view from understanding



2. What/How to ask for Cognitive Domain? (2)

3. Apply

- → Solve typical problems
- → Solve variation problems

4. Analyze

- → Analyze, Differentiate, Classify
- Compare (advantage/disadvantage, pros/cons,...)



2. What/How to ask for Cognitive Domain? (3)

5. Evaluate

- → Compare with criteria
- → Criticize
- → According to ... (theory, belief, ...)

6. Create

- → Design, Synthesize
- → What/If
- → In your opinion, which/when to use... & why



3. What/How to ask for P & A domains?

Psychomotor domain

- → Explain standard process (e.g. appendectomy)
- → What are the precautions of...

Affective domain

- → According to the social norm of...
- → In your opinion, what is the most appropriate action to... & why

4. How to mark SA?

1. Rubric

- → To standardize observers
- → Minimize bias for a fair evaluation
- → Provide a clear and transparent evaluation process
- → Improve reliability



4. How to mark SA? (2)

2. Professional Judgement

The ability to use your knowledge, experience, and skills to make informed, well-reasoned decisions in your field of expertise.

- → Define the criteria and standards
- → Gather and review relevant information
- Consider multiple perspectives



5. What to ask & How to mark SA?

- 1. What → key word/phrase
- 2. Why \rightarrow key process/mechanism
- 3. How \rightarrow key concept for application
- 4. Which/When → key opinion/classification
- 5. What grade/level \rightarrow key argument vs criteria
- 6. What else/How else → key idea/design
